The point of diversion is located in the $\mathbb{N}_4^{\frac{1}{4}} S\mathbb{W}_{49}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ Section 20, T. 13 South, Range 31 East. W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres in SE₄NE₄ Section 26, T. 13 S., R. 30 E., W. M.

John Day River:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

Laycock Creek:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to Sept. 30, measured at point of diversion.

Certificate of water right issued to George and Ralph Gilbert and recorded at page 25229, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 13.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the use of water appurtenant to 8.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered Sept. 24, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to George and Ralph Gilbert.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is . .stricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
