CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That D. VINYARD

of Williams, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Munger Creek

a tributary of West Fork of Williams Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 52 acres and domestic and stock use
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from February, 1877,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.87 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

Certificate of water right issued to D. Vinyard and recorded at page 76353,
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use
of water for irrigation of 58 acres, domestic and stock. Subsequently, the right
to the use of water appurtenant to 6 acres was transferred by order of the State
Engineer dated August 13, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the re-
maining right to the use of water for irrigation and supplemental irrigation and
supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to D. Vinyard.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
