Certificate of water right issued to D. Vinyard and recorded at page 76353, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 58 acres, domestic and stock. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 6 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer dated August 13, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supplemental irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to D. Vinyard.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
