CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That the CITY OF WALLOWA, by J. C. Baird, City Recorder of Wallowa, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek, a tributary of the Wallowa River

for the purpose of General municipal

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 199 that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1906

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6 cubic feet per second; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: General Municipal use in the City of Wallowa, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
