CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN A. SHAW

of North Powder, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed streams Nos. 1, 2 & 3, Gussia Creek, Dry Creek & Shaw Reservoir, constructed under Application No. R-29501, Permit No. R-1810, a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of irrigation of 34.5 acres and supplemental irrigation of 367.0 acres

under Permit No. 23934 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 4, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.42 cubic foot per second, being 0.5 c.f.s. from unn. str. #1, 0.25 c.f.s. from each unn. str.'s. #2 & 3, 3.0 c.f.s. from Gussie Creek & 1.42 c.f.s. from Dry Cr. & 504.0 acre feet from Reservoir storage

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Dry Creek-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25, T. 5 S., R. 38 E., W.M. Unn Str. #3-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 30, Gussie Cr.-NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 19, Unn. Streams #1 & #2 & Dam-NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 31, T. 5 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit number R-1810; provided further that the use of water from Dry Creek shall be limited to those lands described as primary,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
