## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That EIMER HOPKINS

, State of Oregon , has made proof of 1200 Buck Horn Springs Road, Ashland to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Springs Nos. 1 and 2

a tributary of Emigrant Creek Watershed for the purpose of stock and domestic use of one family, including irrigation of not to exceed 2 acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 24800 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 29, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from spring #1 for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring #2 for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}$   $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ , Section 34,  $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ ,  $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ , Section 27, T. 39 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Stock SWZ SWZ Section 27 Domestic NE'S IW'S Section 34 T. 39 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
