CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That the WILSON DITCH ASSOCIATION, by L. E. Caviness, of Joseph, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of the Wallowa River, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 64.05 acres of land, domestic and stock use, and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, in Volume 5, at pages 203, 204 and 205; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1908; that the amount to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  $1\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such rights, add to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 7.6 acres of the following described lands:  
Beginning 11.885 chains South 0 degrees 53' East 46 links; North 87 degrees 50' West of the center of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North 87 degrees 50' West 1436 chains; thence South 0 degrees 50' East 10.45 chains; thence South 87 degrees 50' East 14.36 chains; thence North 0 degrees 50' West 10.455 chains to the place of beginning, containing 15 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 2: 12.5 acres of the following described lands:  
Block 1 of Thomas Morgan tract. Beginning at a point on the North side of right of way of the O R & N Co., whence the SW corner of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian bears South 86 degrees 20' West 736 feet; thence North 58 degrees 46' East 191.4 feet; thence North 31 degrees 14' West 199.98 feet; thence North 58 degrees 46' East 97.02 feet; thence North 0 degrees 50' West 165.66 feet; thence North 87 degrees 50' West 1152.82 feet; thence on an 8 degree concave curve to the left 1360 feet along right of way of the O R & N to place of beginning, containing 12.98 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 3: 20.7 acres of the following described lands:  
Beginning at a point 30 feet South and 19 rods,  $5\frac{1}{4}$  feet west of the NE corner of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 2 S. R. 45 E. W. M., running thence West  $97\frac{1}{2}$  rods parallel with the subdivision line between the North and South halves of said Section 30 to a stake; thence South 45.72 chains; thence East  $97\frac{1}{2}$  rods to a stake; thence North 45.72 rods parallel with the subdivision line between the East and West halves of said Section 30, to the place of beginning, containing 27.8 acres.

Tract No. 4: 5.8 acres of the following described lands:  
Beginning at a point South 0 degrees 53' East 23.1 chains, more or less, thence 47 chains West from the center of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 E. W. M., thence West 14.36 chains more or less; thence South 10.51 chains, more or less; thence North 58 degrees 46' East 16.63 chains; thence North 1.35 chains to South point of beginning, containing 8.57 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 5: 3.6 acres of the following described lands:  
Beginning at a stake whence the center of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East W. M., bears North 52 degrees 43' East 1212.7 feet; thence South 0 degrees 50' East, variation 20 degrees 40' East 264 feet to a stake; thence North 87 degrees 5' West 825 feet to a stake (at 635 feet the E bank of Wallowa River, 40 feet wide course N); thence North 0 degrees 50' West 264 feet to a stake; thence South 87 degrees 5' East 825 feet to the place of beginning (at 165 feet the W bank of the Wallowa River 40 feet wide, course NW) containing 4.99 acres, all in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 6: 4.85 acres of the following described lands:  
Beginning at a stake where the center of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East W. M. bears North 27 degrees 57' East 31.66 chains; thence North 87 degrees 50' West 17.638 chains to the East line of the O R & N Co right of way; thence along said right of way 2.776 chains; thence South 87 degrees 50' East 17.467 chains; thence North 0 degrees 50' West 277 chains to the place of beginning, containing 4.85 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 7: 4 acres of the following described lands:  
Beginning at a point South 27 degrees 57' West 31.66 chains of the center of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of W. M., thence North 87 degrees 50' West 17.638 chains to O R & N Co's right of way; thence in a northwesterly direction along said O R & N Co's right of way 12.682 chains, more or less; thence South 87 degrees 50' East 18.418 chains, more or less; thence South 12.65 chains, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing 10.785 acres, more or less.

Tract No. 8: 5 acres of the following described lands:  
Beginning at a point 30 feet South; thence 30 feet West of the NE corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East W. M., running thence West 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  rods parallel with the subdivision line between the North and the South halves of said Section 30; thence South 45.72 rods; thence East 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  rods; thence North 45.72 rods parallel with the subdivision line between the East and West halves of said Section 30 to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres, more or less.

All of the above described lands being in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the waters aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
