CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 206;

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1881

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $1\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per exce during any periodoof 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrivation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 18 acres in the $NW_{4}^{1}NE_{4}^{1}$ of Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 43 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
