for the purposes of irrigation at the rate of .02 cubic feet per second from May 15th to September 1st of each year and at the rate of .005 cubic feet per second from September 1st to May 1st of each year, including domestic use throughout the year; said domestic use being included within the amount of water allowed for irrigation during the irrigation season for during the irrigation season confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 207; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose Saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed .02 cubic feet per second from May 15th to September 1st of each year and .005 cubic feet per second from September 1st to May 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

1 a.in SV SW1; Sec. 23, Tp. 3 S. R. 40 E. W. M., in Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
