CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LANE W. CROSSLEY

of 2127 Silver Lea Court, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Beaver Creek and Crabtree Creek

a tributary of Santiam River for the purpose of irrigation of 195.2 acres

under Permit No. 27773 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 4, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.44 c.f.s. being 1.66 c.f.s. from Crabtree Creek and 0.78 c.f.s. from Beaver Creek with any deficiency in the available supply in Beaver Creek to be made up by diversion from Crabtree Creek providing the total quantity from both streams (cont)

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Paul DLC 76, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Thomas DLC 70, both in Section 1, T. 11 S., R. 2 W., W. M. (see above) shall not exceed 2.44 c.f.s.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
