CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under State Engineer's permits)

This is to Certify, That J.R LONG, SAMUEL W. LOY, E. H. PRATT, A. L. SAVAGE,
 GEO ENSMINGER, SETH HART AND G. J. SAVAGE
 of Haines, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
 Dutch Flat Creek, a tributary of North Powder River
 , for the purpose of the irrigation of 261 acres of land, and domestic
 use under Permit No. 386 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the
 use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed
 by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of
 Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 389, on the
 13th day of April, 1921; that the priority of the right hereby con-
 firmed dates from July 1, 1910; that the amount of water to which such
 right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually
 beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.36 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is
 appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is
 as follows: 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter and 15 acres
 in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Nine: (30 acres in the
 Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 35 acres in the Southwest quarter of
 Southwest quarter of Section Ten:) 35 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest
 quarter of Section Fifteen:) 35 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast
 quarter; 35 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 8 acres in the
 Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 1 acre in the Southwest quarter of North-
 east quarter; 2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter and 5 acres
 in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Sixteen:) 15 acres in
 the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter, and 17 acres in the Southeast quarter
 of Southeast quarter of Section Seventeen and 10 acres in the Northeast quarter
 of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty, Township Seven South, Range Thirty-eight
 East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-
 eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its
 equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for ir-
 rigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by
 the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
