for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2687h of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 2h, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.56 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEA SWA and NEA SEA, both as projected within Watson DLC #40, Section 29, T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eight ieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre SE4 NE4
2.2 acres SE4 NW4
2.1 acres NE4 SW4
18.2 acres NE4 SE4

all as projected within J. Watson DLC 40
Section 29
T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W. H.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
