of Route 1, Box 42, Gold Beach , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and Squaw Creek

a tributary of Rogue River domestic use of one family and irrigation of 0.46 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27653 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 12, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from spring for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. from Squaw Creek for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEA SEA, Section 4 and RMA NEA, Section 9, T. 36 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water shall be limited to the period when the flow in the Rogue River at its mouth is more than 735 c.f.s.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.25 acre SW1 SE1 Domestic and 0.15 acre SE1 SE1 Section 4

0.01 acre NE1 NE1 O.05 acre MV1 NE1 Section 9

T. 36 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
