**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** RIVERSIDE GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

of 8105 N. E. 33rd Drive, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of air conditioning

under Permit No. G-2114 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 11, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12, T. 1 N., R. 1 E., W. M. Well located 750 feet S. and 880 feet W. from the center of Section 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is further described as being a part of Tract 38 of Sunderland Acres

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
