of 628 Pittock Block, Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Celilo Park Well

a tributary of Columbia River (The Dalles Reservoir) irrigation of 6.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-1567 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE SE SE SE SE SE SE SE CORNER OF SECTION 17, T. 2 N., R. 15 E., W. M. Well located N. 57° 45 minutes W. 850 feet from the SE corner of Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be nited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for eac. acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state off er.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which each right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
