This Is to Certify, That ESTATE OF MINNIE SHELDON

of Route 1, Box 218, McMinnville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a sump

a tributary of Yamhill River supplemental irrigation of 20.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-1728 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 21, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entified and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SET SWT as projected within Garrison DLC 66, Section 13, T. 5 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Sump located between 1040 feet N. and 950 feet N. and 2100 feet E. from the SW corner of Section 13,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
