CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARION DUNLAP

of Route 1, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, Big Applegate River and reservoirs constructed under Appl. number R-27664, Permit number R-1433 a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 17.3 acres

under Permit No. 21785 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 19, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second, being 0.15 c.f.s. from Applegate River and 0.07 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and reservoirs,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under Permit No. R-1433,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
