## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WILHEMINE KIESEL SHEARMAN & WILHEMINE KIESEL SHEARMAN, TRUSTEE

of Ogden , State of Utah , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17871 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 18, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.23 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 ( $NE_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ ), Section 9, T. 19 S., R. 47 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Wilhemine Kiesel Shearman & Wilhemine Kiesel Shearman, Trustee, and recorded at page 19793, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 294.7 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the use of water appurtenant to 205.7 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered November 20, 1964. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Wilhemine Kiesel Shearman & Wilhemine Kiesel Shearman, Trustee.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
