for the purposes of
irrigation
 under Reservoir Permit No. **R-2025** of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 27, 1957**

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed **50.22 acre feet**
