## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Stevens' infiltration well

a tributary of Bear Creek (Rogue River) irrigation of 3.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-2107 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of scid waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 3, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE¼ SE¼ as projected within Colver DIC ¼3, Section 15, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Infiltration well located between 1800 feet N. and 1500 feet N. and 1250 feet W. from the SE corner of Section 15. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed ½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.9 acre NE SE 1 2.9 acres NV SE 1 both as projected within Colver DLC 43 Section 15 T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
