a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 77.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters G-1552 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 7, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE & SW &, Section 28, T. 6 S., R. 3 W., W. M. Well located 19½ chains N. and 9½ chains W. from the S. quarter corner, Section

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eight ieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
