**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** NORTON & DEAN (a partnership)

of P. O. Box 606, Bandon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Johnson Creek

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 14.5 acres

under Permit No. 26237 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 23, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, T. 29 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and if for the irrigation of cranberries, shall be limited to one-tenth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre feet for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be further limited to a diversion of (cont. below) and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$

not to exceed 6 acre feet per acre during the irrigat~~ion~~ season of each year;

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
