Rt. 5 Box 387, Eugene , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Coquille River

a tributary of Coquille River irrigation of 39.1 acres and stock for the purpose of

of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 7, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second, being 0.49 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 10 (NM SWA) Section 30, T. 28 S., R. 11 W.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21 acre feet per acre for each acre rrigated during the irrication season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:

9.2 acres and stock Lot 9 (NE $_{4}^{2}$ SW $_{4}^{1}$) 5.3 acres Lot 10 (NW $_{4}^{1}$ SW $_{4}^{1}$) 7.6 acres and stock Lot 10 (SWa S 法) 15.1 acres SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄
0.1 acre Lot 8 (NW¹/₃ SE¹/₄)
1.8 acres Lot 8 (SW¹/₄ SE¹/₃) Section 30 T. 28 S., R. 11 W., W. N.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
