## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** R. C. & HELEN L. WEAVER

of Box 27, Harbor, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek

a tributary of Winchuck River for the purpose of domestic use of one family, including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden

under Permit No. 28487 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 9 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 6, T. 41 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 9 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 6  
T. 41 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is described as follows:

Beginning at a point 1056 feet East of the NW corner Lot 9 Section 6, T. 41 South, R. 12 West; thence East 264 feet; thence South 1320 feet; thence West 264 feet; thence North to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
