CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MONICA KINNEL

of Alicel _____, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed slough and Grande Ronde River

a tributary of Snake River _____ for the purpose of irrigation of 256.41 acres

under Permit No. 27541 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 19, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.62 cubic feet per second; water to be diverted from unnamed slough when available and any deficiency in the available supply in unnamed slough is to be made up by diversion from Grande Ronde River, providing that the total (cont. below) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (Grande Ronde River) & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (Unnamed Slough) both in Section 4, T. 2 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 c.f.s. at U.S.G.S. Gage No. 3325 and more than 420 c.f.s. at U.S. G.S. Gage No. 3330;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

quantity diverted from both streams shall not exceed 1/40th c.f.s. for each acre irrigated.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
