a tributary of Snake River irrigation of 139.1 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 28468 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 29, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.64 cabic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW\$\frac{1}{4}\$ SW\$\frac{1}{4}\$ and SW\$\frac{1}{4}\$ SW\$\frac{1}{4}\$, Section 10; NW\$\frac{1}{4}\$, Section 15; and NE\$\frac{1}{4}\$, NE\$\frac{1}{4}\$, Section 15. 1 S., R. 39 E., W. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second

per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited

to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated

during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to

use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde

River is more than 300 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 3325 and more than 120 c.f.s. at

Oregon-Washington border;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

(cont. from above) and E. 160° and S. 997.0° and W. 800° from the NE corner of Section 16.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
