CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN L. CARTER

of Long Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributury of Spring Creek (John Day River) for the purpose of domestic use for one family, irrigation of 1.7 acres and stock

under Permit No. 14377 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 2, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.065 cubic foot per second being 0.035 c.f.s. for irrigation, 0.015 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.015 c.f.s. for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the \mathbb{N}^1_4 \mathbb{N}^1_4 , Section 27, T. 10 S., R. 30 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, for each acre irrigated prior to June 1st and thereafter 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month prior to June 1st and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to September 30th of each year, and shall be limited still further to a total diversion of not to exceed 0.035 c.f.s.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.7 acres, stock and domestic NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ stock SW¹/₃ Section 22
T. 10 S., R. 30 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to John L. Carter and recorded at page 17266, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 3.6 acres and domestic use of one family and stock. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 1.9 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered April 7, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation, domestic and stock and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to John L. Carter.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
