CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALBERT M. ROWE

of Box 45, Days Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River and Days Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation and stock use

under Permit No. 17547 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 12, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.145 cubic foot per second; being 0.105 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.01 cubic foot per second for stock from river, and 0.03 cubic foot per second for irrigation from creek.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9; T. 30 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Albert M. Rowe and recorded at page 24101, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 23.4 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 8.3 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered January 13, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Albert M. Rowe.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
