that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed (see below)

The point of diversion is located in the

Dixie Creek: 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre feet per acre during season April 1 to Sept. 30, measured at point of diversion.

John Day River: 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to
Sept. 30; further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar
month to July 1 and 3/4 acre foot per acre thereafter; total five
acre feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

Certificate of water right issued to Wm. J. Galbraith Estate and recorded at page 25208, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 190.7 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the right to the use of water appurtenant to 86.1 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered March 15, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to war. J. Galbraith Estate.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
