**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is To Certify, That** LUTHER S. & NELL M. POE

of Route 2, Box 165, Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Yamhill River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 12.5 acres under Permit No. 14751 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 11, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 17, T. 4 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
11.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
1.0 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the Central corner of the division line of the DLC of Stewart Hanna and wife Not. No. 795, Claim No. 44 in T. 4 S., R. 3 W., W. M., in said Yamhill County, Oregon, said beginning point being on the North Bank of the Yamhill River in Section Numbered 17, as established by C. Handley and C. J. Handley on March 10th, 1876; thence running N. 22° 15' E. on said Central Division line of said DLC 13.12 chains to stake from which then an oak 12 inches in diameter bore S. 20° E. 6.04 chains distant marked C. S. 5 C. B. T; thence running N. 80° 30' W. 23.00 chains to stake on the East line of lands formerly owned by W. P. Ruddicks and known as the "Ruddicks" tract; thence S. 22° 15' W. on the East line of said "Ruddicks" tract 15.57 chains to the Southeast corner of said "Ruddicks" tract as established on the North bank of the Yamhill River; thence following down said River with the meanderings thereof to the place of beginning, and containing 30 acres, and being part of the West half of the DLC of Stewart Hanna and wife, above named.

Certificate of water right issued to Luther S. & Nell M. Poe and recorded at page 15122, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 19.5 acres. Subsequently, a change in point of diversion for the right to the use of water appurtenant to 7.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered June 20, 1963. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Luther S. & Nell M. Poe.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
