CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ARLEY ACTON

of Drewsey , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of the waters of Middle Fork Malheur River

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Harney County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 1, 1905

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, one acre foot per acre in any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year, or three acre feet per acre during any season diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

28.0 acres $NE^{\frac{1}{2}} SW^{\frac{1}{2}}$

Certificate of water right issued to Arley Acton and recorded at page 6844, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 204 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 74 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered December 16, 1960. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Arley Acton.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
