CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEO. E. STEVENSON

of Route 2, Box 810, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Lost River

a tributary of irrigation of 223.9 acres, domestic and stock for the purpose of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 5, at page 94; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1888 for 147.9 acres and 1902 for 76 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.80 cubic foot per second during the irrigation season, and a quantity for domestic and stock purposes outside the irrigation season at the rate of one half cubic foot per second for each 1000 head of stock.

Certificate of water right issued to George E. Stevenson and recorded at page 27619, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 251 acres and domestic and stock. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 27.1 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered January 18, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to George E. Stevenson.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
