CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOSEPH W. DODD

of Tygh Valley, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Tygh Creek

a tributary of White River for the purpose of
irrigation of 20.35 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 196; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre
during any irrigation season (with the further limitations contained in Para-
graph 24 of said decree),

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

1.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3
11.8 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
7.35 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 10
T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Joseph Dodd and recorded at page 31417,
Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the
use of water for irrigation of 44.56 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use
of water appurtenant to 24.21 acres was transferred by order of the State
Engineer entered January 13, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the
remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certifi-
cate heretofore issued to Joseph Dodd.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
