CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PEOPLES WAREHOUSE

of Pendleton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of McKay Creek

a tributary of Umatilla River irrigation of 18.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 644: of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 11, 1924

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured to the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NET SET and SET SET, Section 5, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.0 acres NE NV 7.8 acres SE WV 7.8 acres SE WV 7.0 acres NV 4 SE 3.5 Section 5
T. 1 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Peoples Warehouse and recorded at page 11696, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 11.0 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the right to the use of water appurtenant to 22.2 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered June 21, 1963. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Peoples Warehouse.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
