## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** GEORGE H. & WILLIAM HALL, JR.

of **Prairie City**, State of **Oregon**, has a right  
to the use of the waters of **John Day River**

a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of  
irrigation 83.3

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
**Grant** County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume **15**, at page **461**; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from **1863 - Tract #1**  
**1867 - Tract #2**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **one-fortieth** of one  
cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to Sept. 30; further limited  
to one acre foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and  $\frac{3}{4}$  acre foot per acre  
thereafter; total five acre feet per acre for season, measured at point of diver-  
sion

The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$** , Section 9, T. 13 S., R. 33 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

Certificate of water right issued to George H. & William Hall, Jr. and recorded  
at page 25268, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms  
a right to the use of water for irrigation of 94.3 acres. Subsequently, the  
point of diversion for the use of water appurtenant to 11.0 acres was transferred  
by order of the State Engineer entered March 15, 1965. This certificate is  
issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and  
supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to George H. & William Hall, Jr.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
