CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN W. KOPPLIN

of Route 2, Gaston, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River and Hill Creek

a tributary of _____ for the purpose of
irrigation of 50.0 acres

under Permit No. 12373 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 4, 1936;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.63 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, being 0.56 cubic foot per second from Tualatin River, and 0.07 cubic foot per second from Hill Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M., NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 2 S., R. 4 W., W. M., and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.9 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
5.3 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
18.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
4.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
8.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

all as projected within Welch DLC 41
Section 7
T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

6.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Welch DLC 41
Section 12
T. 2 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered July 16, 1953, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to John W. Kopplin and recorded at page 11933, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
