## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

*This is to Certify, That* WILLIAM BLOOM,  
of Cove, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of MILL CREEK, a tributary of Catherine Creek and the Grande Ronde  
River, in Union County, State of Oregon, which said right consists of the use  
of the water overflowing from Rees Mill ditch,

for the purpose of irrigation from March 1st to September of each year and  
domestic use throughout the year; said domestic use being included within  
the amount of water allowed for irrigation during the irrigation season;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of  
Oregon for Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,  
in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at  
page 207 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1890;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the  
purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-  
pose, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water  
hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water  
is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

14 a. in NW-1/4; Sec. 21, Tp. 3 S. R. 40 E. W. M., in Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the  
lands or place of use herein described.
