CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That TRUMAN V. DORZAB AND ELLA DORZAB
of 1344 Lincoln Street, Hood River, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
two small streams

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of
irrigation of 0.4 acres

under Permit No. 4098 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from May 26, 1919

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 26

T. 3 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is further described as being Lots 9,
10, 11 and 12 of Idlewild Addition to the City of Hood River.

This certificate is issued to supersede the water right certificate recorded in
State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 5, page 3941, pursuant to the
order of the State Engineer entered May 26, 1965, so as to correctly describe
the right.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
