that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5 cubic feet per sec-

The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NW4, Section 17, T. 20 S., R. 36 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to S. S. Williams and recorded at page 7043, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 326.0 acres. Subsequently the point of diversion for the use of water for irrigation of 72.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered April 8, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to S. S. Williams.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
