CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **APPLEGATE INVESTMENT COMPANY**
 By **Billie Joe Hunter** 97530
 of **Route 1, Box 22-D, Jacksonville**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Forest Creek and Hunter and Best Reservoirs Nos. 1 and 2 constructed under appli-
ication No. R-34097, permit No. R-2370
 a tributary of **Applegate River** for the purpose of
irrigation of 23.1 acres and supplemental irrigation of 42.9 acres

under Permit No. **26859** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from **July 5, 1960**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.83 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$** as projected within **Bishop DLC 42, Sec-**
tion 23, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second
 per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be
 further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet** per acre for each
 acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and
 storage from reservoirs constructed under permit No. **R-2370**; provided further
 that the right to the use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow
 of the Rogue River is more than **735 c.f.s.** at its mouth,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:
