CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALBERT AND ALTHEA F. BURELBACH

of 12 1/2 Miller Avenue, Dallas, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rickreall Creek

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of domestic use of one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 29388 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Tuthill DLC 42, Section 36, T. 7 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
as projected within Tuthill DLC 42
Section 36
T. 7 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is further described as follows:
Beginning at an Iron Pipe at the Southwest corner of Tract 1, Lauterman's LaCreole Summer Home Tracts in Township 7 South, Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Polk County, Oregon; and running thence North 89° 30' East 258.4 feet to an Iron Pipe at the Southeast corner of said Tract 1; thence north 27° 24' West 100.92 feet to an Iron Pipe; thence South 89° 30' West 212.74 feet; thence South 0° 30' East 90.0 feet to the place of beginning and containing 0.487 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
