A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 2h, 196h, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Daniel and Minnie Butler and recorded at page 5607, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
