## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ARTHUR AND ELIZABETH APPLING

of Dufur, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Eight Mile Creek

a tributary of Fifteen Mile Creek for the purpose of  
irrigation of 17.0 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Wasco County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 406; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1891

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre  
in any irrigation season

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, T. 1 S.; R. 13 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

17.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 21  
T. 1 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved  
by an order of the State Engineer entered September 24, 1964, and supersedes  
certificate of water right heretofore issued to Daniel and Minnie Butler and  
recorded at page 5607, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
