## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** GLEN MORIN

of 1031 Resort Street, Baker, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek and Little Spring Creek

a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of irrigation of 80 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1888 for 26 acres; 1864 for 19 acres and 1865 for 35 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 27, T. 8 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

40 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
40 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 27  
T. 8 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered August 18, 1961, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Myrtle Manary and recorded at page 4325, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
