## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify. That RAYMOND C. AND NONA FLAGG

of Elkton Star Route, Drain , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir, constructed under application No. R-37687, permit No. R-2991

a tributary of Elk Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 0.6 acre and maintenance of a reservoir for fish culture

under Permit No. 28106 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 22, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NW_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$  NE $_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$  and Lot 1 (NE $_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$  NN $_{4}^{\frac{1}{4}}$ ), Section 14, T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under permit No. R-2991; provided further that the right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 c.f.s. at tidewater,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish Culture & O.6 acre NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Fish Culture Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4)
Section 14
T. 22 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
