## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** VIRGINIA KATHERINE AYER, successor in interest to Ben E. and Elizabeth Harder,

of Rt. 1, Box 238, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 27.2 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.54 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres in Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 32,

4.9 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
20.7 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 33,  
T. 34 S., R. 1 W. W.M.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered May 11, 1953 and recorded at page 534, Volume 7, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
