CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAUL H. and MABEL L. CASSELL, successors in interest to Paul S. Sealey,

of Route 1, Box 58, Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic, stock and irrigation of 13.6 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.5 acres in Lot 11 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) chg. pt. of div.
 7.1 acres in Lot 11 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Sp. Or. V. 15 p 408
 Section 15,
 T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 28, 1956 and recorded at page 493, Volume 8, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
