## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.61 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE4 NE4, Section 11, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 16.0 acres in Lot 7 (NW NW SW NW) 20.5 acres in Lot 8 (MY MY) Section 22, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

The above Lot designations are in Pleasant Valley Farm Tracts, as designated, numbered and escribed on the official plat thereof now on record in the office of the County Clerk of Jackson County.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
