## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CALVIN and EARL STEPHENS,

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right  
to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
domestic, stock and irrigation of 17.0 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per  
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

10.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
6.6 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 15,  
T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

all of which are included in the  
following-described tract:

Beginning 503.4 feet South of NE corner of Section 15, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.;  
thence South 734.5 feet; thence North 75° 45' West 2,332 feet to center of  
Evans Creek; thence North 52° 15' East 689 feet along the center of Evans Creek;  
thence South 83° 15' East 1,791 feet to beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
