CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK H. ADAMS,

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
domestic, stock and irrigation of 20.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.7 acres in that part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying West of Evans Creek and South of a line beginning at the NW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 4, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; thence in a Northeasterly direction to a point in Evans Creek 470 feet Northwesterly of the center of said Section 4.

16.7 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4,
T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
